



HVIP Public School Bus Set-Aside

Scrappage Guide

Participation in the Public School Bus Set-Aside requires the scrappage of an old school bus(es). Scrappage can occur after Terms and Conditions have been fully executed and must occur within 365 calendar days of new school bus delivery.

Scrappage requirements can be found in the HVIP Implementation Manual, Appendix G. Proof of scrappage utilizes a [Dismantle Certification Form](#) and requires supporting documentation and photos. Scraping is an important step in this program and must be done according to Public School Bus Set-Aside requirements and guidelines. The difference between the Public School Bus Set-Aside voucher amount and standard HVIP eligible school bus voucher amount must be refunded to CARB if the purchaser fails to meet the requirements.

To be considered a complete submittal, use the following Checklist:

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:


- [Dismantle Certification Form](#) (one separate form per scrapped School Bus)
- A copy of the DMV Dismantler's Notice of Acquisition /Report of Vehicles to be Dismantled (REG 42) (preferred)
- OR,*
- DMV Junk Slip **AND**
- Completed [Certificate of Destruction](#) from the entity destroying the school bus

PHOTOGRAPHS REQUIRED:

- Photographs documenting proper school bus chassis and school bus engine destruction:
 - Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) plate
 - Engine plate depicting engine serial number
 - Photograph(s) depicting the method used to scrap the engine portion of the school bus.
 - To dismantle the engine portion a 5-inch hole **must** be cut into the engine block
 - Photograph(s) depicting the method used to scrap the non-engine portion of the school bus (chassis)
 - To dismantle the school bus chassis means to punch, crush, stamp, hammer, shred or otherwise render permanently and irreversibly incapable of functioning as originally intended

ATTENTION Dismantlers: Please review the requirements below PRIOR TO Dismantle!

This form should **only** be completed if the DMV Dismantler's Notice of Acquisition/Report of Vehicles to be Dismantled (REG 42) is unavailable. If the DMV REG 42 form cannot be provided, this signed Certification of Destruction Form from the entity destroying the school bus **AND** a DMV Junk Slip, along with required photographs, may be accepted. Photographs required (See Dismantle Certification Form for examples of acceptable scrappage photographs):

- Photograph of Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) plate
- Photograph of engine plate depicting engine serial number
- Photograph(s) depicting the method used to scrap the engine portion of the school bus. To dismantle the engine portion a 5-inch hole **must** be cut into the engine block.
- Photograph(s) depicting the method used to scrap the non-engine portion of the school bus (chassis). To dismantle the school bus chassis means to punch, crush, stamp, hammer, shred or otherwise render permanently and irreversibly incapable of functioning as originally intended.

Documents required (in addition to this form):

- DMV Junk Slip
- [Dismantle Certification Form](#) (one per school bus)

The school bus(es) identified below were scrapped according to the HVIP Implementation Manual, Appendix G, Public School Bus Set-Aside. The Program requires that the old school bus(es) must be scrapped and rendered permanently incapable of functioning as originally intended.

Please note: CARB or its administrator may, in their sole discretion, require additional documentation to ensure scrappage requirements have been met. Additionally, in the event that funding from other sources becomes available, CARB or its administrator may require additional documentation to comply with specific requirements of the new funding source (such as Diesel Emissions Reduction Act funding).

Be Prepared!

The Dismantler may require documentation to complete the scrappage process. We encourage you to contact your Dismantler **prior to arriving** and ask what is required, for example:

- Do you accept School Buses for scrappage?
- What information or documentation do I need to bring?
 - For example: School Bus Title, Pink Slip, Registration, Bill of Sale
- Do any documents need to be signed to be accepted?
- Is there a fee for scrappage?
